

## **PSA AND SPSF (SA BRANCH) NOVEMBER COUNCIL MEETINGS**

The PSA and SPSF (SA Branch) Councils met on Monday 19 November. Highlights from the meetings included:

### **SHARED SERVICES**

The General Secretary Jan McMahon provided a detailed report on this issue. PSA has been meeting with the Shared Services Reform Office and raising members concerns. Fundamental differences remain unresolved at this time, as PSA seeks to ensure that members and the community do not suffer losses through the introduction of Shared Services.

PSA officials and Industrial Officers are visiting affected membership areas, including regional locations, to meet with members and discuss concerns.

Council resolved to endorse action by members to protect their entitlements and services to the community.

### **AGENCY REPORTS**

Details of agency specific issues were provided to Council, including IT concerns within DTEI, reviews within State Library, operating hours for Fisheries Officers and the implementation of the Land Services Group Review.

Councillors representing Correctional Services provided a report on the critical lack of accommodation for prisoners in the South Australian prison system.

Workload and staffing concerns were identified across many agencies.
