## Workload Protections

PSA members identified protections from unreasonable workloads as a priority during our extensive membership engagement process. Protecting members from unreasonable workloads is an underlying principle throughout the PSA's proposed new Enterprise Agreement.

The PSA's proposals contain a new option of Workload Consultative Forums for protecting members from unreasonable workloads (clause 13.2).

Specific workload dispute and grievance resolution processes remain an option for dealing with unresolved unreasonable workload matters.

Workload protections are just one area of improvement for members contained in the PSA's proposed new Enterprise Agreement.
