



KEEP STABILITY FOR DISABILITY

Around 500 people with disabilities living in Supported Community Accommodation are among the most vulnerable people in our community. They need and want a consistent and stable environment with support from people they know and trust.

Under the NDIS, there needed to be changes in how this service was run so the previous state government set up a public corporation in order to keep stability for clients.

The new state government wants instead to privatise the service to the NGO sector. They made this announcement without discussion with clients, their families or staff.

Clients do not know who their provider will be, where they will be living and who will support them. This proposal has left families with no or little information about the future housing for their loved ones.

We call on the state government to reconsider the proposal and reinstate the public corporation so there is stability for people with disabilities living in Government Supported Accommodation.
